What is the Board??

The Journey Board of Directors is the group of individuals who meet at least four times per year to: Seek the leading of the Lord in every aspect of planning, preparing and conducting the weekends; plan, promote & encourage Journey activities for high school age & young adult candidates; select directors to lead weekends; provide & adjust budgets for the weekends and oversee financial aspects of the organization; establish & maintain policies & guidelines to ensure consistency of the weekends. Board members generally serve a three year term, with no more than two consecutive terms.

What is a "Community Representative"??

The Board has two types of members: Officer, and Community representative. A "community representative" is a voting member of the Board, and is designed to be an at-large representative of the Board in the member's home region (i.e. Lewiston/Clarkston, Spokane, Tri-Cities, Walla Walla, North Idaho, etc.). If you have a question or concern you'd like brought to the Board's attention, contact your local representative! Community Reps also serve on committees, helping with special projects, such as policy reviews, etc. If you're interested in serving as a representative of your community, please contact Jeremy Lanthorn, board president.

Looking Forward

The JWC Board, under the guidance of the Trailer Guardians and concerned community members, have been actively pursuing the purchase of a new supply trailer. The current trailer was several years old when JWC acquired it many years ago, and despite regular maintenance and upkeep, the trailer simply is at the end of it's usable life.

JWC needs to purchase a safer, more reliable trailer. With an estimated cost of about \$5000-\$6000, this is major investment for our community.
